In the Kemetic sacred Science, the universe originated from a primordial ocean called Nu.



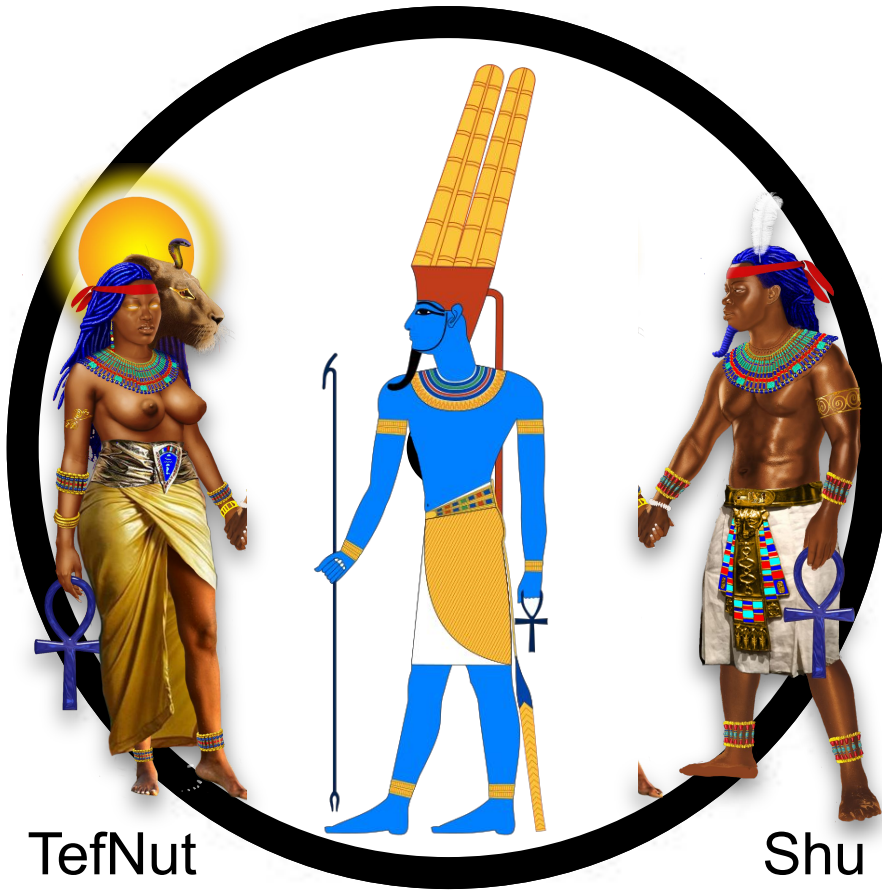

Out of Nu comes Amen the central point from which the universe is created

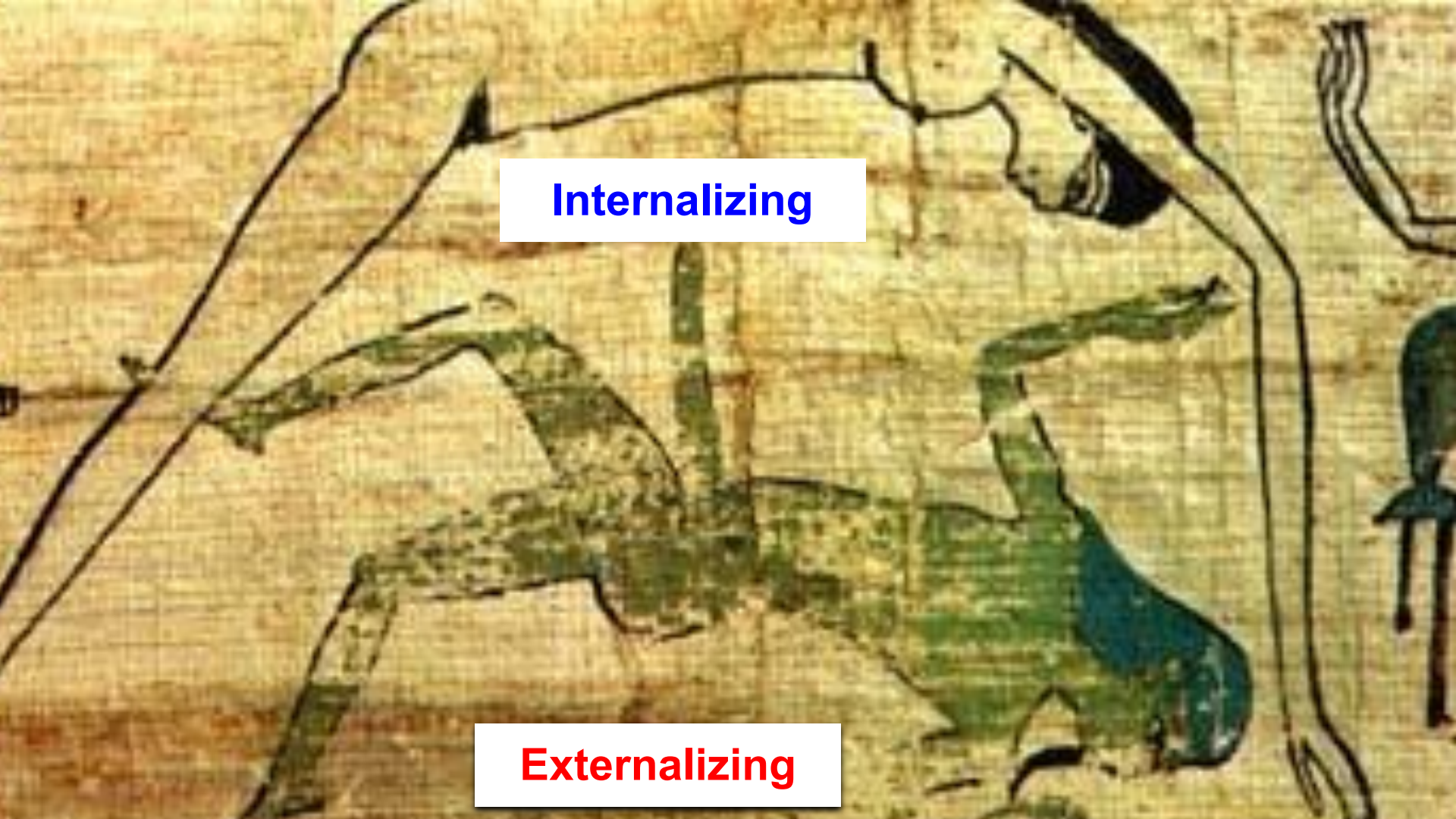
Amen's breath of life inspired an island to form from the water to support him.

From there. Amen, then created Tefnut (moisture) and Shu (Dry)



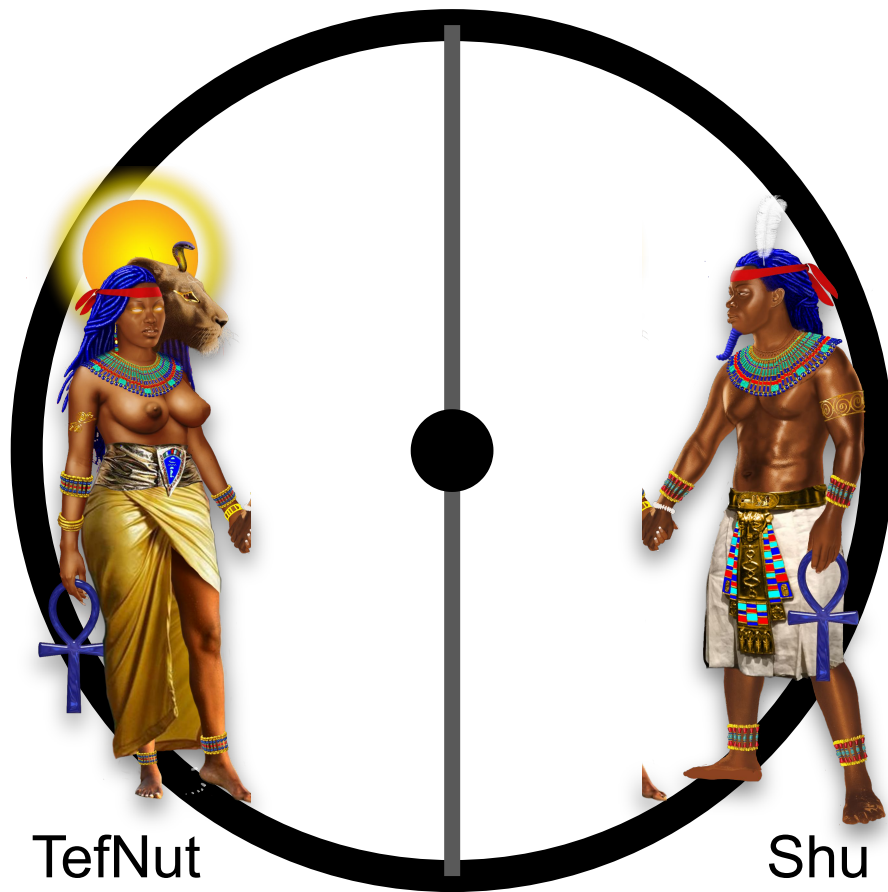

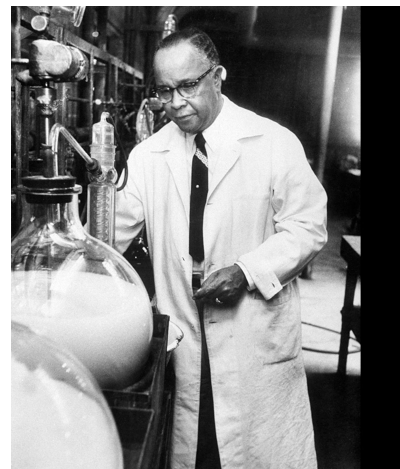


Cold is Introverted

Talkative, Action-oriented, Enthusiastic, Friendly, Warm, Fun-loving, Open about themselves, Spontaneous, Lively

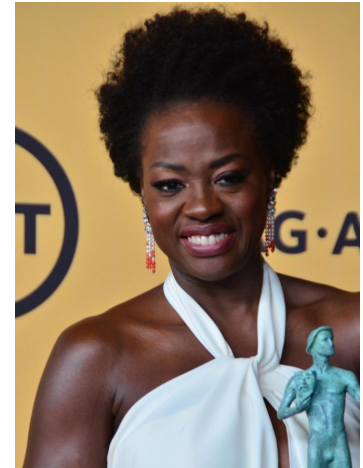
Extroverts (Hot) may enjoy being the center of attention, group work, and talking about their thoughts and feelings.

They may also be good at communicating for stimulation, filling in awkward gaps in conversations, and offering lots of information.



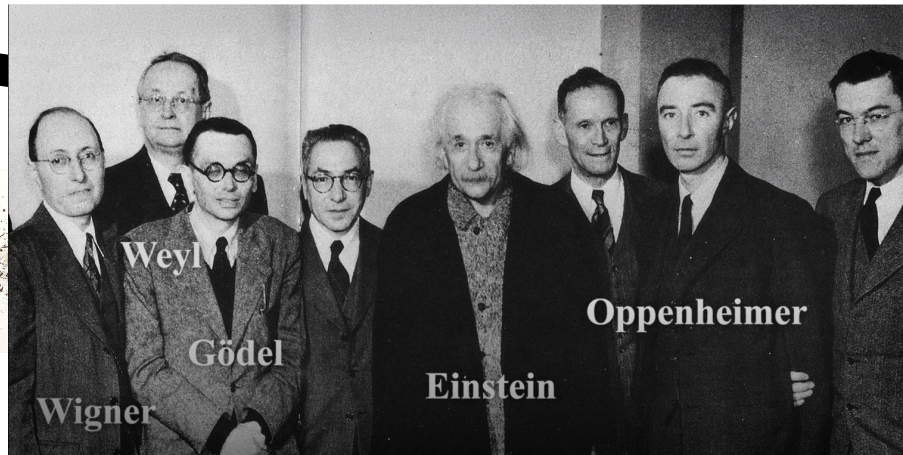

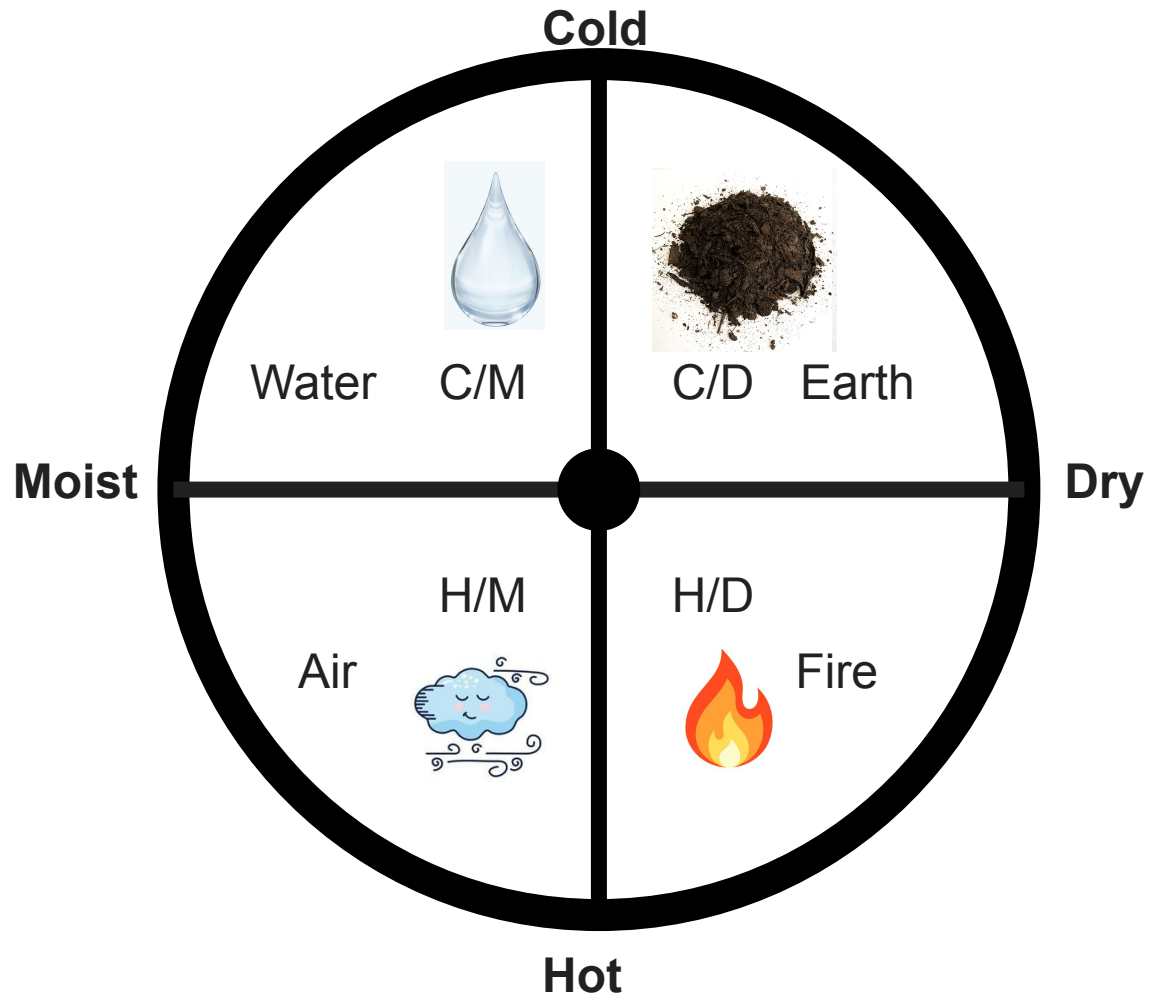

As you might imagine, those who fall into the H/M archetype are extroverts.

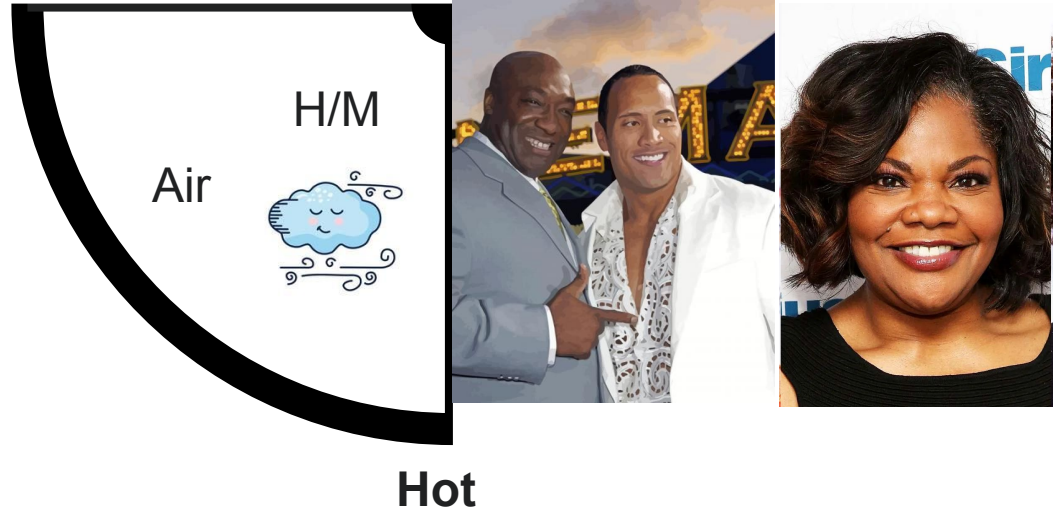
With high energy levels and an insatiable curiosity, people with this temperament tend to love adventures and seek out new experiences. **Moist**

However, these individuals are easily devastated if not constantly reassured that they are loved and appreciated.

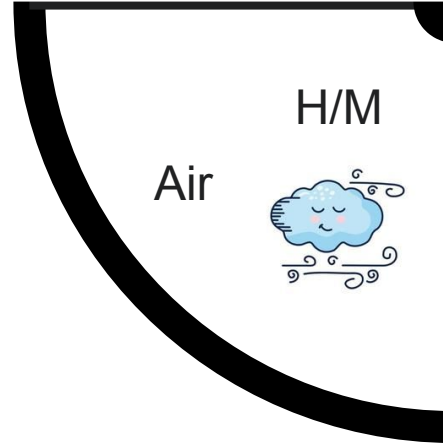

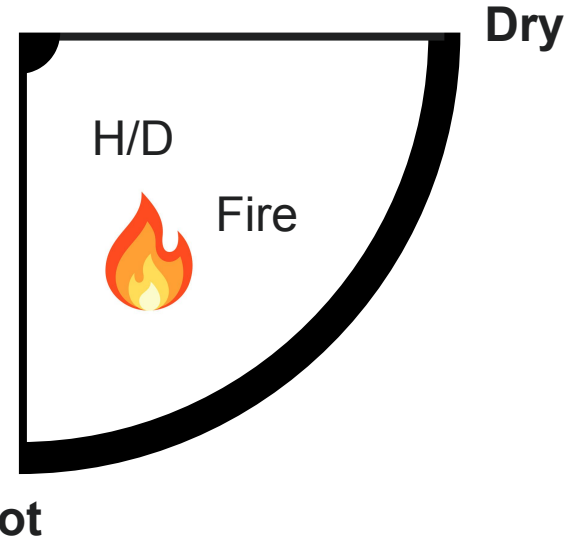
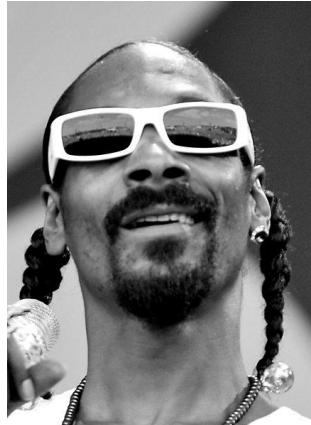
The H/D These people like to speak their mind with dominance and strength. Their source of power comes from their mental strength - which is evident through their knack for critical thinking and creative problem-solving.

They know what they want and they keep going until they reach their goal - and nothing you say can change that.

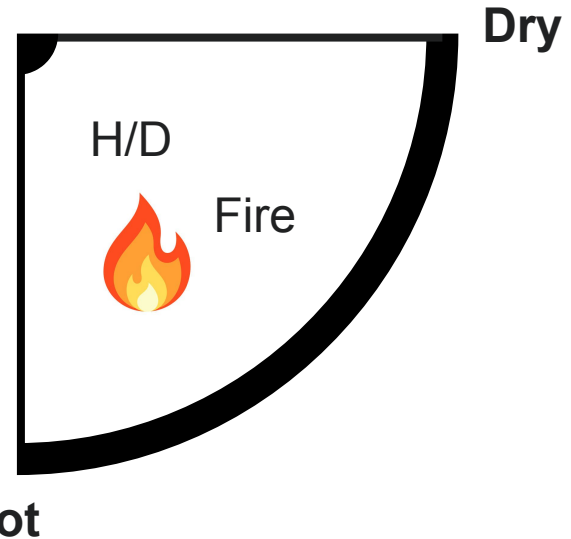
Fear is an unfamiliar concept to the H/D - at least, that's what they want you to think.

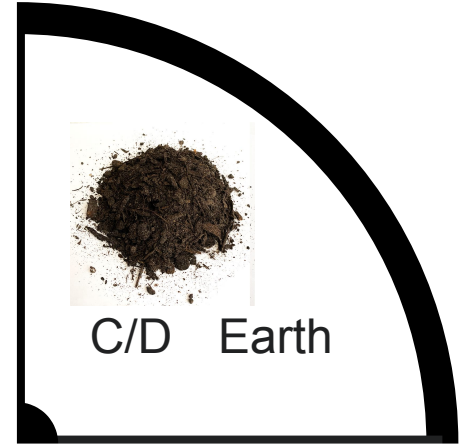

You could describe them as hard workers, reliable, and trustworthy. They put in a lot of the grunt work

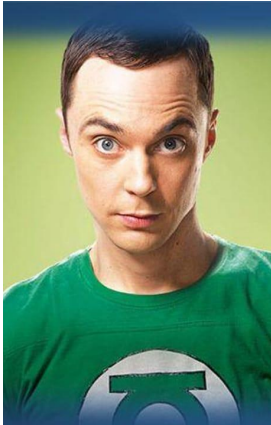
But the downside to this attitude is, that these individuals often struggle to share their thoughts when the outcome could result in conflict.

For C/M types, quality surpasses quantity.

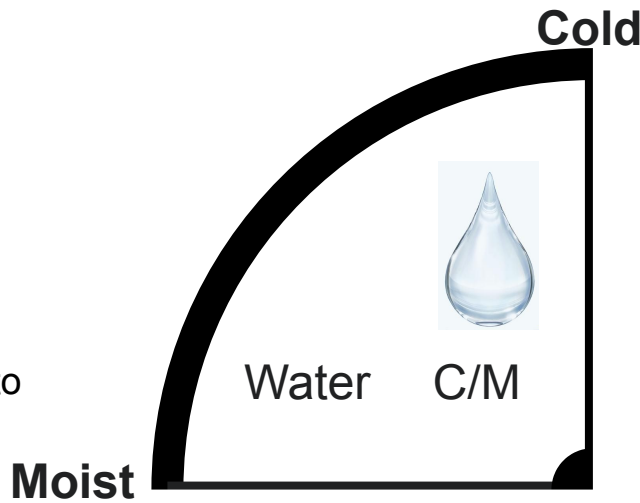
They would rather have a few close friends than many acquaintances.

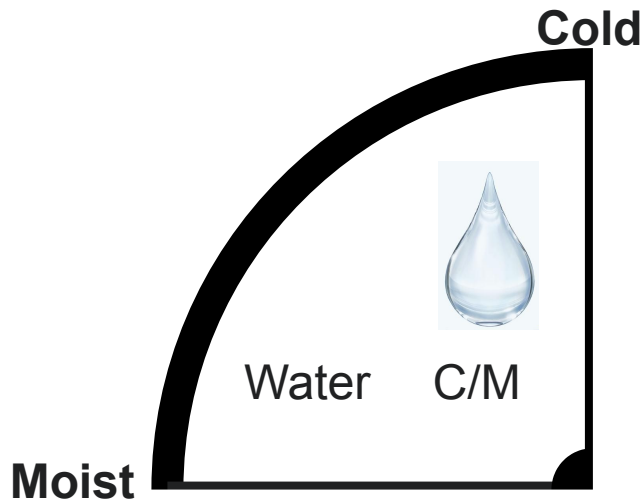
C/M types tend to fantasize about meeting their ideal partner - and they seek out people who fit that perfect image.

They hold others to exceptionally high (and often unrealistic) standards - setting themselves up for disappointment.

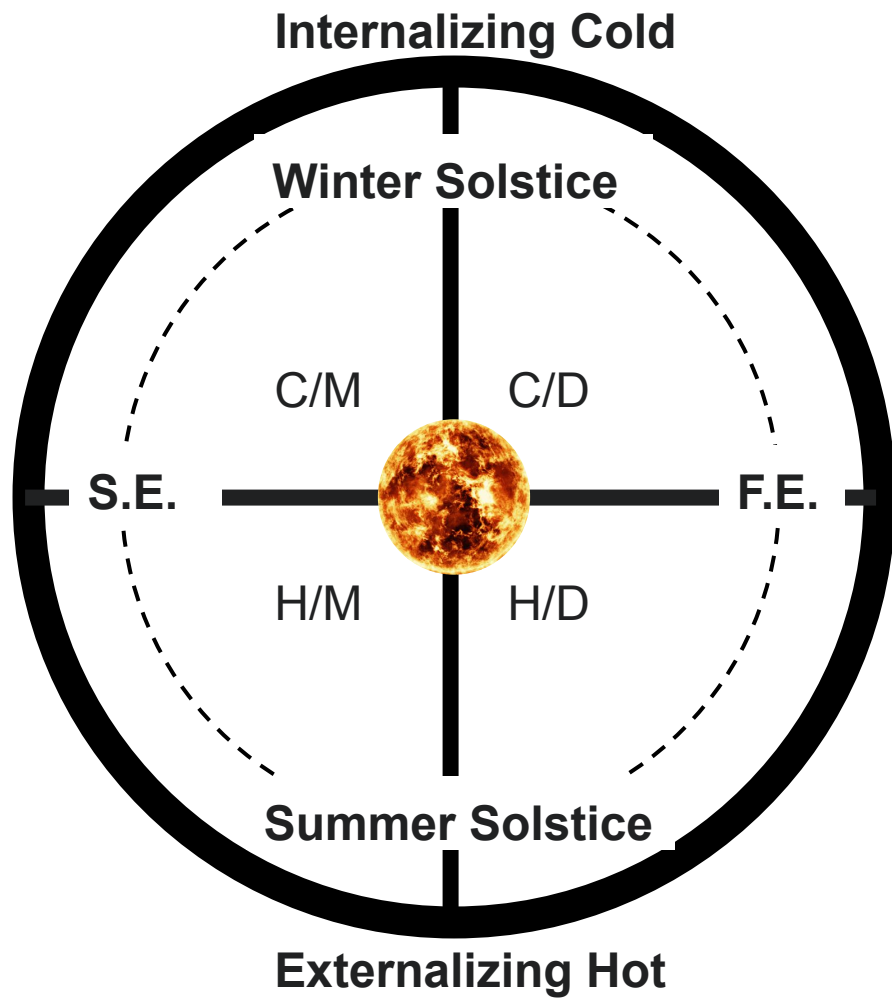
In addition to these downfalls, C/M types also tend to be emotional overthinkers.

And they like to read into subtle body language - often to the detriment of their relationships.

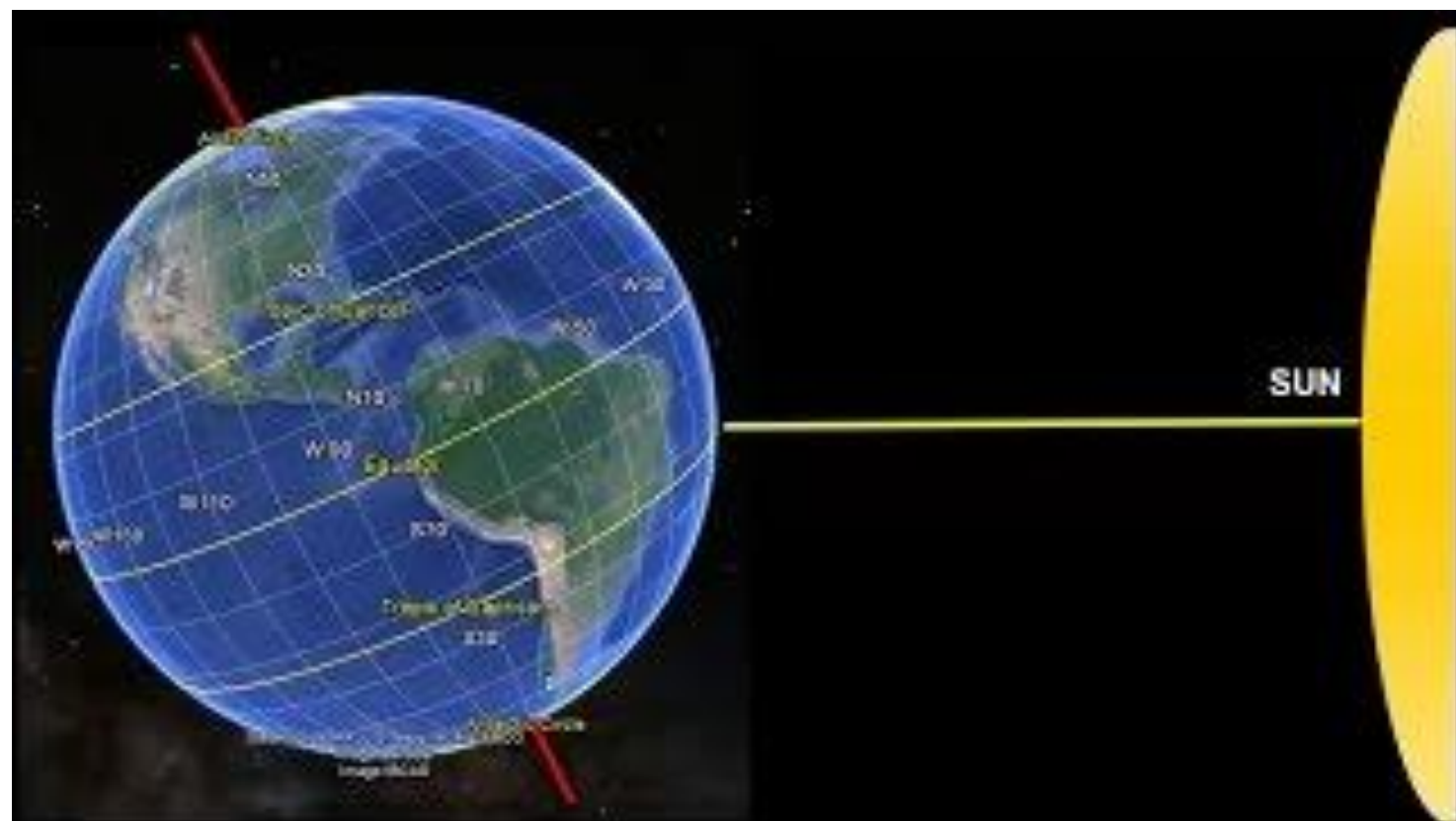


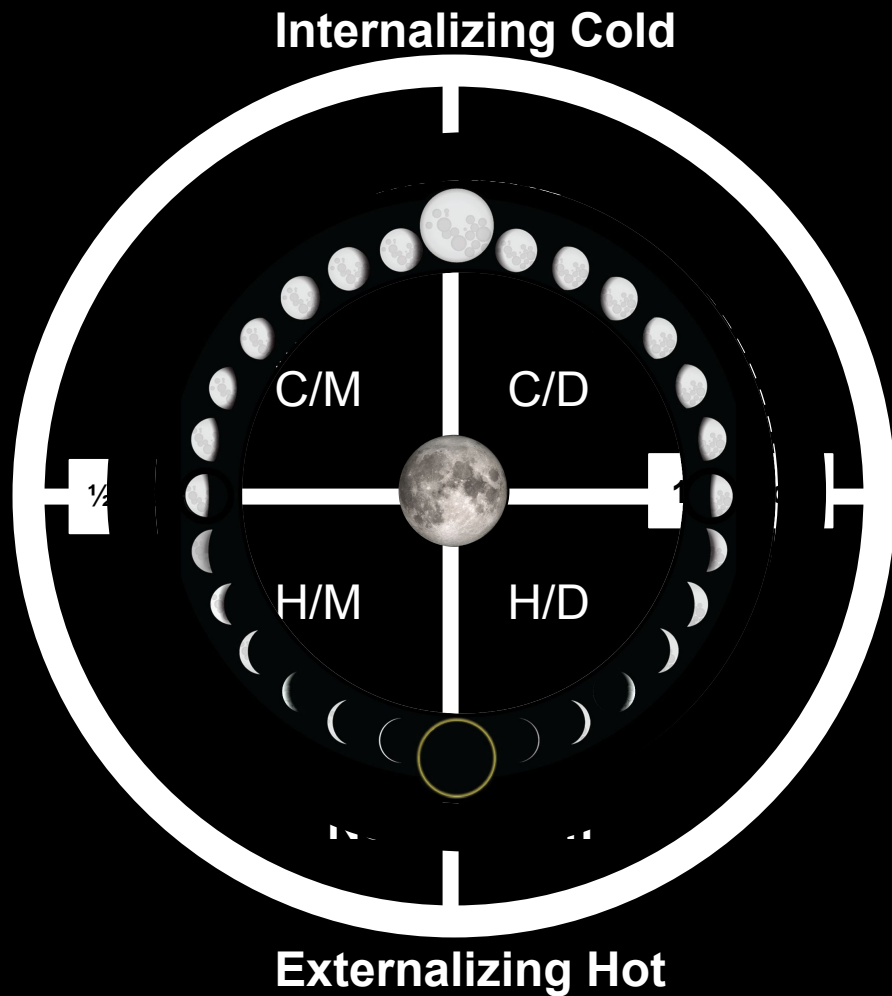
